Inspection Procedure

Inspection of the premises of the users of weights-measures, weighing and measuring instruments in transaction and protection, is done by the local Inspector/Legal Metrology Officer under the relevant provisions of the *Legal Metrology Act 2009*. As per the provisions, challan is done by issuing seizure memo, if on such an inspection any weight or measure or weighing and measuring instrument found not conforming to the standards i.e., found defective or it is found to be used fraudulently. At the same time, during such inspections, inspection of commodity transacted using such weight or measure or weighing or measuring instrument and related documents may be also be done.

Apart from above, inspections are also conducted in view of the provisions of 'Legal Metrology (packaged Commodity) Rules 2011' made under the 'Legal Metrology act 2009'.
